



Chafee Education and Training Voucher (ETV)

Eligibility Requirements:

- Maintain GPA requirements
- Be enrolled at least half time in a college or career school that is approved by the U.S. Department of Education for Title IV student assistance programs
- Demonstrate financial need for the grant (as determined by the postsecondary institution)

Reasons To Take Action:

1. College is expensive and using resources you qualify for can help you reach your educational goals!
2. ETV can help you pay for things scholarships may not (transportation, food, clothing, housing, etc)
3. You can receive ETV funds until the term before you turn 26 and can claim it for 5 years

Tips:

- Ask your case worker if you qualify for Chafee ETV (Education and Training Voucher)
- Ask your case worker for documentation of being in foster care, sometimes called a Verification Letter
- Complete your FAFSA first to access grant, scholarship and ETV money.
